- Window coverings can be expensive and many schools only have the cheap and unattractive plain roller shades. Create attractive décor by dressing up your windows quickly, easily, and inexpensively.
- Attach paper Washi tape to make lines and designs on your existing shades. It comes off quickly and easily when you are ready for a change.
- Post student work, anchor charts, or use spray adhesive to attach fabric to existing roller shades. Maps work well as decoration and can be hidden when the shade rolls up. *Don't use hot glue on plastic shades!*
- Use a plastic tablecloth, duct tape, and a tension rod to make a quick curtain.
